

IOSH Managing Safely

Overview

The Managing Safety course is accredited by the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH). The course is designed to provide delegates with the knowledge and tools required to tackle the health & safety issues they are likely to encounter in the modern working environment.

An important aspect of this course is the reinforcement of health and safety as a key responsibility for any supervisory or managerial role and not something that can be left to 'health and safety' professionals.

Dedicated courses provide the opportunity to make reference to specific procedures or documentation used within the customer's organisation and to highlight any relevant hot topics.

Who should attend?

Anyone in a role with supervisory or managerial responsibility, or is moving into this type of role.

What will they get out of it?

What they need to know and are perhaps reluctant to learn about in a refreshingly informal way. Managing safely won't turn delegates into safety experts, but it will give them the knowledge and tools to tackle the health and safety issues they are responsible for. Importantly, it brings home just why health and safety is such an essential part of their job.

Course Content

The course includes the following topics:

Law and Regulations

- An overview of the key pieces of legislation and regulation that apply to the workplace.

Risk Management

- Understanding, assessing and controlling risk to 'reasonably practicable' levels.
- Investigating Accidents at Work Investigating accidents in the workplace to establish immediate and root causes.
- Health & Safety Performance Indicators. Analysing reactive and proactive health & safety performance indicators.

- Environmental & Pollution Management Appreciate the fundamental requirements of effective environmental waste and pollution management.

Assessments

There is a theory assessment at the end of the course coupled with a practical risk assessment that must be completed and returned within 2 weeks.

Duration and Approach

The duration of the training is four days and uses a range of techniques to create an engaging and interesting learning environment. Alternatively we can deliver this course over three extended days should this fit better operationally.

Certification

Successful delegates will be awarded an IOSH 'Managing Safety' certificate.
